By Virtue of a Warrant under the Hand of The Hon<sup>ble</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Fairfax Esq<sup>r</sup> and Seal of His Lordship the Proprietor's Office, Bearing Date the Tenth Day of February 1747, Empowering me to Resurvey a Tract of Land Granted to Captain William Russell by Patent bearing Date the \_\_\_\_\_ Day of \_\_\_\_\_ for Three Thousand Six Hundred and Fifty Acres on the E<sup>t</sup> side of Shenandoah River and Happy Creek: I have Surveyed as follows.

Beginning at (A) the Mouth of Happy Creek, Thence up the several Courses thereof, (According to M<sup>r</sup> Warner's Survey.) S 47° 28' Poles. S 39° E 50 Poles. S 7° E 38 Poles. S 31° W 34 Poles. S 18° E 27 Poles. S 15° W 26 Poles. S 44° W 64 Poles. S 37 1/2° W 80 Poles. S 20° E 94 Poles. S 15° W 80 Poles. S 19° E 60 Poles. S 10° E 311 Poles to (B) 3 Hickory Saplings and a Poplar on the W<sup>t</sup> side of Happy Creek, Thence N 66° W 306 Poles to 3 white Oaks and a red Oak Saplings (at C) Thence S 1/2° W 240 Poles to (D) a Spanish Oak and a Chestnut Oak on the side of a Mountain called Dicker's Hill, near to the Dividing Line between Frederick and Augusta Counties, Thence S 61° W 90 Poles xing a Branch 220 xing another ditto 254 xing a Road 380 xing ditto 510 xing a Branch 565 Poles to (E) 2 Chestnuts a red Oak and Hickory on a Ridge near to a Path, Thence S 19° W 200 xing a Run 276 xing a branch of Gooney's Run 320 xing a Path 380 xing a large branch 597 xing Gooney's Run alias Sugar Tree Creek 878 Poles to (F) 2 Hickories & a large white Oak on the side of a Piney Mountain at some Distance from a Branch of Flint-Run. Thence N 25° W 358 xing a large Branch of Flint-Run 478 xing Flint-Run 518 Poles to (G) 3 white Oaks on the Top of a Cliff on the River Banks 30 Poles above the Mouth of Flint-Run, Thence down the several Courses of y<sup>e</sup> River as follows, viz. N 85° E 32 Poles xing the Mouth of Flint-Run, N 65° E 72 Poles. N 51° E 25 Poles. N 34° E 27 Poles xing the Mouth of Gooney's Run. N 16° W 18 Poles. N 18° W 29 Poles. N 3° E 26 Poles. N N W 20 Poles.
